Framework

Most Recently Used file list included in the File menu.

LiveSet window is now resizable in height.

Rack height is now saved in the file format.

ReWire Configuration Tool has been integrated in the Preferences dialog box (ReWire panel).

Non-Rewired mode has been enhanced.

ASIO audio engine has been enhanced.

New virtual cables colors.

Few minor bugs have been fixed.

LiveSet now recognizes Combinator device in Reason 3.0.

ReWire Connection labels are automatically refreshed.

Devices smart filtering has been enhanced.

Modules

New TamTam module.

X2: Added Flip Channel feature.

MXN8 / MXC8: Swap inputs is now featured to create split chains. Swap and Mode buttons can be remotely controlled via MIDI triggers.

Chordion: Decay values can now be synchronized with tempo.

MidiOut: Added Midi Clock synchronization message generation.

Impact: Controls and detects new Line Mixer device in Reason 3.0.

ReLoop: Points/Blocks can be renamed and cleared. Points/Blocks
