*PeterTools*, the italian software house behind *LiveSet* and *Hammer* softwares, announced the release of a Mac OSX version of the *audio input tool* for Propellerhead's Reason, Hammer. This utility finally provides Macintosh users with the capabilities to route audio inputs into Reason rack for live processing: adding a reverb, doing cool voice vocoding or guitar distortion. The software will be released on boxed CDs before the summer, a public beta-testing program is to begin in early April 2007.
